



This comic is drawn in Japanese manga style. Please read from right to left, from top to bottom, as in the example below.









Bitch of the Jungle: The Story So Far

Japanese archeologist Major Tanimoto and German adventurer Josef Clausen hired Batu, a wild man also known as the Malayan Tarzan, as their guide to find the legendary Red City, deep in the jungle. This was a hidden city built by the king of the Srivijaya kingdom in the 7th century for the purpose of secret religious rituals. When they arrived in the city, they encountered Kumbhakarna, a mysterious monk who looked like a mummy. This monk had originally been a Brahmin from the 11th-century Indian Chola dynasty and had, as a follower in the eastern expedition of King Rajendra I, arrived in the Red City, where he became an immortal sorcerer through a secret ritual and survived in solitude for hundreds of years.

Kumbhakarna used his magical powers to expose the true identity that Tanimoto and Clausen had been hiding. In reality, they were Japanese and German military spies, and their objective was not some kind of archeological discovery, but rather to obtain the vast amounts of gold hidden in the Red City for their homelands' war chest and the possession of the underground oil reserves in this land.

Batu's real name was Shigeru Ishigami. He was the only child of Viscount Koji Ishigami, a Japanese explorer who went missing on Sumatra thirty years ago, and Lady Raja Kuning, a heir to the royal house of the Langkasuka kingdom. The Ishigamis died together in an unfortunate accident, and as a very young child Shigeru was raised by the Orang Pendek, ape men living hidden deep in the jungle. And when he had grown up as a strong man and returned to human society with the chivalry inherited from his father and the indigenous spirit of his mother, he became a resistance fighter against the colonial rule of the imperialists and a champion of the liberation movement.

Tanimoto and Clausen joined forces with Kumbhakarna and planned to poison Batu. But aroused by Batu's body, Kumbhakarna secretly swapped the poison for an aphrodisiac. The power of the ancient, terrifying drug transformed this noble fellow – a resistance fighter and man of the jungle – into a perpetually horny, obscene monkey.
